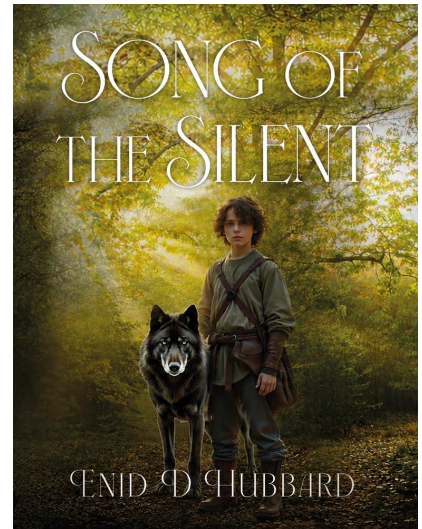


Song of the Silent
